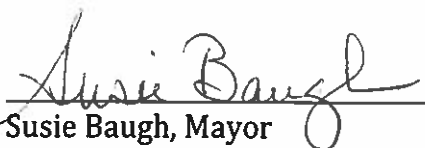

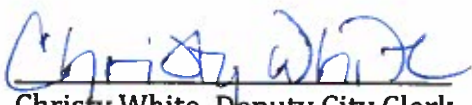
Mayor Baugh announced that the Council sat in Closed Session with no reportable actions.
