City Manager Jeff Kiser gave a staff report in regards to the employment agreement with Jonathon Poletski and answered questions from Council. City Attorney Collin Bogener gave a staff report regarding the employment contract for the City Manager reflecting increasing in pay due to pay compaction.




Newly appointed Chief Poletski spoke thanking Council for the opportunity to serve Anderson and expressed his excitement to be a part of the community.
