PUBLIC HEARING: URGENCY ORDINANCE TO EXTEND REGULATING NON-MEDICAL MARIJUANA

The City Council received a report and update on the status of marijuana and the need for a continued moratorium from City Manager Jody Burgess.

James Yarbrough spoke in favor of extending the moratorium.
No other comments were received.

6:21 p.m.: The Public Hearing was closed.

By motion made, seconded (Baugh/Neutze) and carried by a 5-0 vote, the Council adopted Urgency Ordinance No. 811 extending the moratorium imposed by Urgency Ordinance No. 802, and extended by Ordinance No. 803, to regulate cultivation and prohibit the manufacture, processing, laboratory testing, labeling, storing, wholesale or retail distribution of non-medical marijuana within the City limits of the City of Anderson for an additional twelve months pursuant to Government Code Section 65858(a).

The City Clerk read the ordinance by title only.
