Bank Robbery-Suspect In-Custody

On Monday, July 13, 2015, at 1:29 pm the Auburn Hills Police Department responded to a bank robbery at the Chase Bank at the corner of Opdyke and Walton Roads. The suspect entered the bank, implied he had a weapon and demanded money from the teller. The teller handed over an undisclosed amount of money to the suspect. The suspect then fled the bank on foot.

Officers began canvassing the area speaking to employees at nearby businesses. One of those employees called police stating that a man matching the description of the suspect just came into her office asking to use her phone. Officers set up a perimeter while Oakland County Sheriff's K-9 and aviation unit responded. The Oakland County Sheriff K-9 tracked and located the suspect a quarter mile away hiding in storage yard of a business.

The suspect, a 36 year old man from Almont, Michigan, was taken into custody quickly and without incident due to the cooperative police work between the Oakland County Sheriff's Department and Auburn Hills Police Department.

The teller was not injured in the incident. The stolen cash was recovered.
