Officer Injured on Traffic Stop

On October 23, 2015, at approximately 2:03 am, an Auburn Hills Police Officer made a traffic stop on a vehicle near Opdyke Road and Pontiac Road. The officer placed the driver under arrest. The driver fought with the officer and was able to get back into her vehicle. The driver then backed her vehicle up striking the officer and the officer's patrol car. The driver then fled the scene in her vehicle.

The suspect vehicle was located a short distance away in a hotel parking lot. We believe the driver was picked up from a nearby gas station.

The officer sustained non-life threatening injuries from the incident. He was transported to McLaren Oakland Hospital where he was treated for his injuries.

The officer is 37 years old and has been with the department for 4 years.

Officers are actively looking for the 22-year-old African-American female driver from Pontiac.
