SHOTS FIRED

On Friday, May 15, 2015, at approximately 6:25 p.m. the Auburn Hills Police Department responded to the 4400 block of Castlewood after a 911 call was received. The caller reported a violent and intoxicated subject with a gun inside a residence. The caller reported that the subject who was suicidal/homicidal had fired the gun inside the home. The 911 operator directed the caller to flee the residence if it was possible and safe.

A shelter in place messages was issued for the neighborhood until the situation was rendered safe.

Officers arrived on scene and attempted to make contact with the subject by phone. The subject came out of the residence and was taken into custody without incident.

The subject, 42 year old Oxford man, was visiting his parents at the residence. He was taken to McLaren-Oakland Hospital for a medical clearance before being lodged at the Oakland County Jail. No one was injured during the incident.

At the start of the incident a request for assistance was made to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office for additional units and their SWAT team. The SWAT team was cancelled due to the incident being resolved so quickly. Two Deputies assisted at the scene. The shelter in place advisory was lifted when the scene was safe.

The incident remains under investigation.
