Monthly Report: January 2022

Reckless Discharge of a Firearm

On January 1, 2022, at 04:53 am, Officer Clemence and Officer McDonnell were dispatched to 235 Tree Top Circle for reports of someone discharging a firearm in the parking lot.

The investigation revealed that a 22-year-old male from Auburn Hills was having a gathering at his residence. During the evening a physical altercation occurred and the home owner asked several people to leave. The home owner exited his residence and fired two shots into the pavement in an attempt to get the unwanted guests to leave.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Reckless Discharge of a Firearm.

Domestic Assault

On January 1, 2022, at 06:46 pm, officers were dispatched to 3230 Five Points Drive for a domestic violence incident.

The investigation revealed that a 23-year-old female from Auburn Hills, was assaulted by her boyfriend. The suspect a 29-year-old male from Auburn Hills, was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Domestic Violence 3rd Offense.

Assault with a Dangerous Weapon

On January 1, 2022, at 11:09 pm, officers were dispatched to 705 Hill Crest Circle for a possible domestic violence incident.

The investigation revealed that a 20-year-old male from Auburn Hills, was assaulted by his girlfriend. The suspect held a knife to her boyfriend's throat. The suspect a 22-year-old female from Auburn Hills, was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Assault with a Dangerous Weapon and Domestic Violence.

Possession of a Controlled Substance

On January 5, 2022, at 9:39 pm, Officer Anderson made contact with a suspicious male near 2100 University Drive.

The subject provided officers with information regarding narcotics transactions occurring at 1294 Opdyke. Officers made contact with an individual at 1294 North Opdyke Road, who was found to be in possession of Methamphetamine, Heroin, and Fentanyl. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with 3 counts of a Controlled Substance.

Receiving and Concealing a Stolen Vehicle

On January 12, 2022, at 03:48 am, Officer Anderson was dispatched to the area of University Drive and I-75 for a motorist assist.

The investigation revealed that the subject was traveling on University Drive when his vehicle ran out of gas. The vehicle that the subject was driving had been reported stolen out of Flint, on December 14, 2021. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Receiving and Concealing a Stolen Motor Vehicle and Driving Without a Driver's License.

Threats of Violence

On January 12, 2022, at 5:50 pm, Officer Saikal and Detective Smith responded to 2647 Croft Hill Drive for an incident involving a student at the Avondale High School.

The investigation revealed that a 15-year-old male from Auburn Hills made a threatening comment during class. The individuals' belongings including his residence were searched. The subject was lodged at Oakland County Children's Village.

Possession of a Controlled Substance

On January 22, 2022, at 4:00 pm, Officer Wagner was dispatched to 1180 Doris Road.

The reporting party advised that a subject staying at the hotel had a parole violation warrant for their arrest. Officers made contact with the subject, who was found to be in possession of Methamphetamine, Cocaine, Amphetamine, and Fentanyl.

The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Possession of a Controlled Substance and Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer.

Robbery

On January 23, 2022, at 08:40 am, officers were dispatched to 3995 Auburn Road for a robbery.

The investigation revealed that the suspect entered the store and produced a handgun demanding money. The suspect took \$300.00 out of the cash register and exited the store towards Adams Road.

On January 24, 2022, the suspect was located by the Oakland County Sheriff's Department during a traffic stop in Pontiac. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The suspect was responsible for three robberies at the location over the past several months.

Domestic Assault

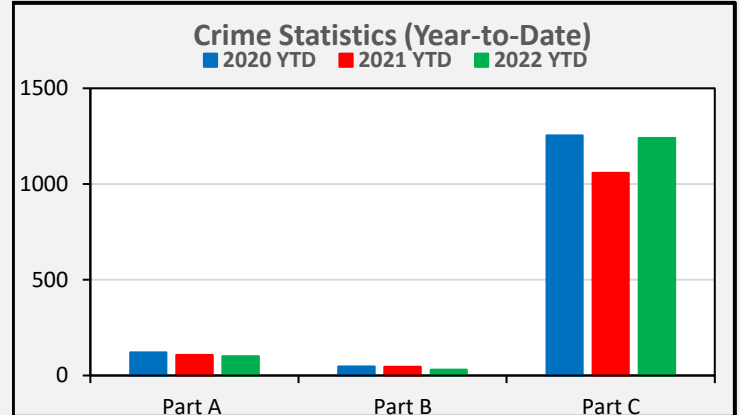
On January 25, 2022, at 12:05 am, officers were dispatched to 2385 South Boulevard for a domestic violence incident.

The investigation revealed that a 60-year-old female from Auburn Hills, was assaulted by her daughter. The suspect, a 30-year-old female from Auburn Hills, was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

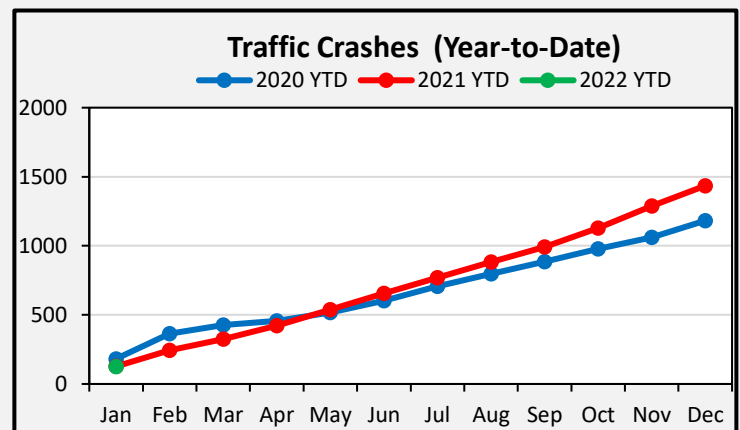
The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Domestic Violence, Resist/Obstructing a Police Officer, and Child Abuse 4th Degree.

Crime and Service Statistics

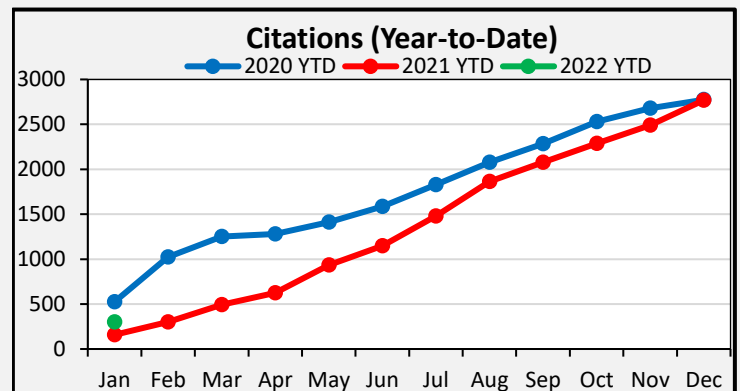
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.



Year to date we have experienced a -5.61% decrease in Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -33.33% decrease in Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and an 17.09% increase in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service-related incidents) compared to 2021.



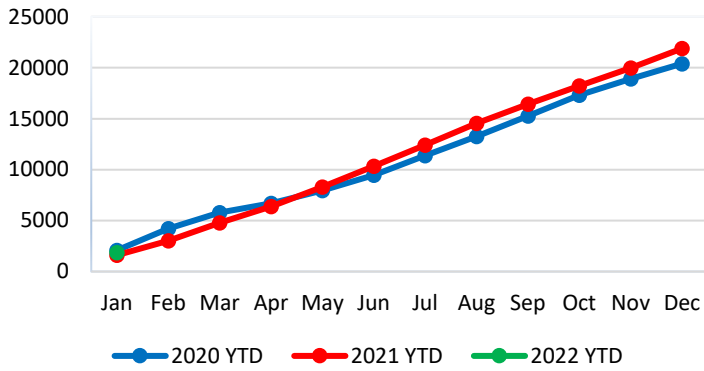
During January, we handled 126 crashes. Year to date we have experienced a -0.79% decrease in traffic crashes compared to 2021.



Officers issued 300 citations in January 2022. Year to date we have experienced an 89.87% increase in citations issued compared to 2021.

Calls for Service

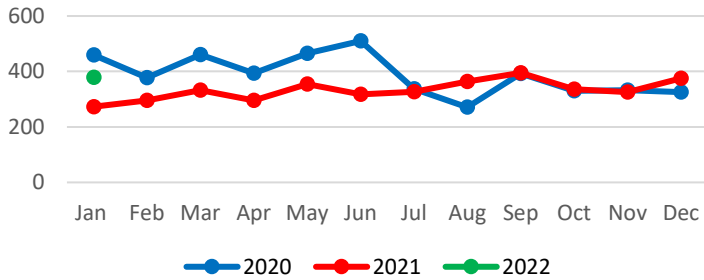
Calls for Service (Year-to-Date)



Officers handled 1867 calls for service during January, which is an 15.82% increase compared to 2021.

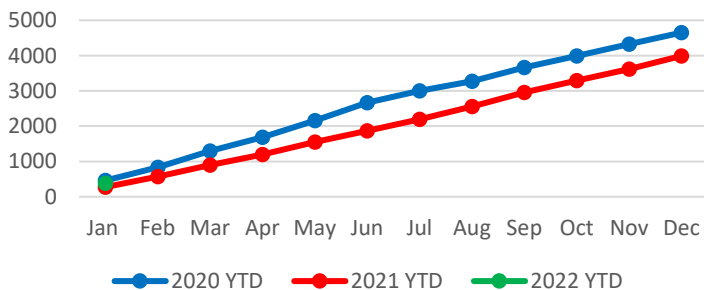
Time in Neighborhoods

Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year-to-Date)

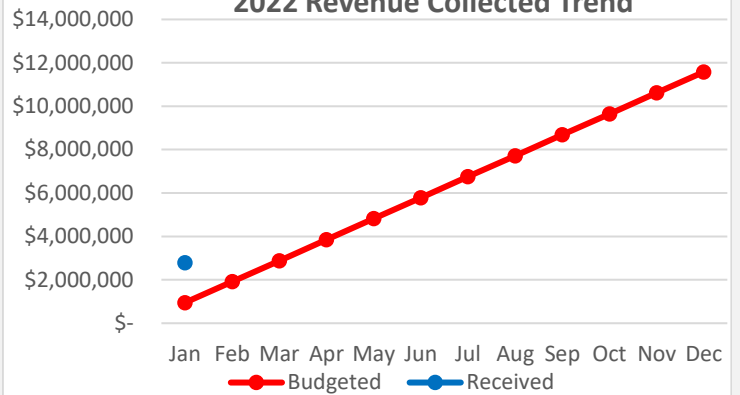


Year to date we have spent 379 hours in our neighborhoods, which is an 38.85% increase compared to 2021.

Financial Reports

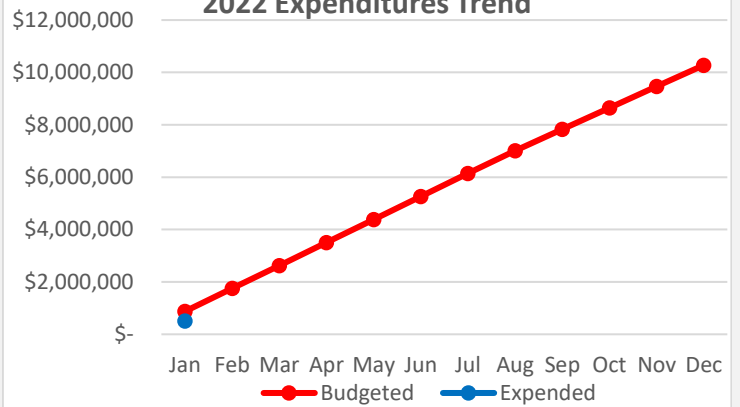
We continually analyze our department expenditures to ensure we remain within our approved budget, while delivering the best possible service to our community.

During January, we received \$2,788,167.36 in revenue.

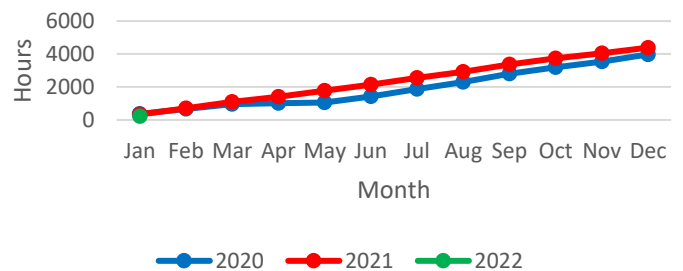
2022 Expenditures Trend
