Concealed Weapons

On June 6, 2020, at 9:48 pm, Officer Journeau was traveling northbound on Opdyke Road near M-59 when he observed a vehicle disobey a traffic control device.

The investigation revealed that the driver did not have any form of identification with him and was carrying a concealed firearm without a permit.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for Concealed Weapons, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, and Driving While License Suspended.

Operating While Intoxicated

On June 13, 2020, at 11:09 pm, officers were dispatched to the area of northbound I-75 and M-59 for a report of a vehicle driving erratically.

Officer McDonnell located the vehicle traveling northbound on I-75 near Lapeer Road and conducted a traffic stop. Officer McDonnell could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. The driver submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which yielded a result of .184.

The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for Operating While Intoxicated Child Endangerment and Driving While License Suspended.

Concealed Weapons

On June 14, 2020, at 03:04 am, Sergeant VanLandeghem and Officer Townsend conducted a traffic stop on northbound I-75 near M-59 for a vehicle weaving out of its lane multiple times.

The investigation revealed that the driver was carrying a concealed firearm without a permit. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Carrying a Concealed Weapon.

Officer Ochadleus

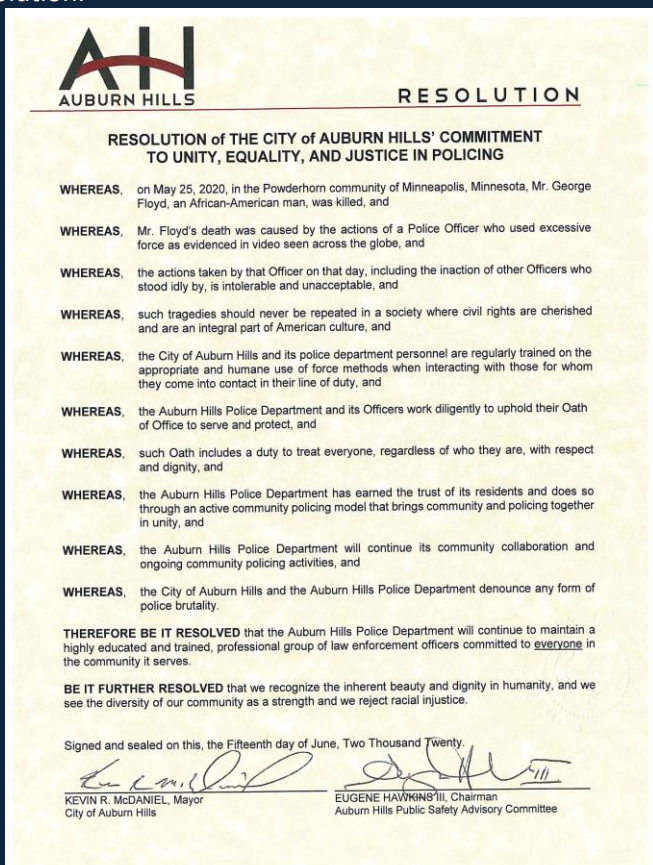

Felonious Assault

On June 21, 2020, at 6:32 pm, officers were dispatched to 2100 Featherstone Road for a trouble call.

The investigation revealed that the responsible subject threatened another guest at the hotel with a knife. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Felonious Assault.

Unlawful Driving Away of Automobile

On June 30, 2020, at 3:42 pm, Officer Brehmer responded to 3315 University Drive for an Unlawful Driving Away of an Automobile incident that had just occurred.

The investigation revealed that the vehicle was taken from the parking lot while the delivery driver was making a delivery to the hotel.

The Oakland County Sheriff's Department located the vehicle in Pontiac. The driver of the vehicle was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Unlawful Driving Away of an Automobile.

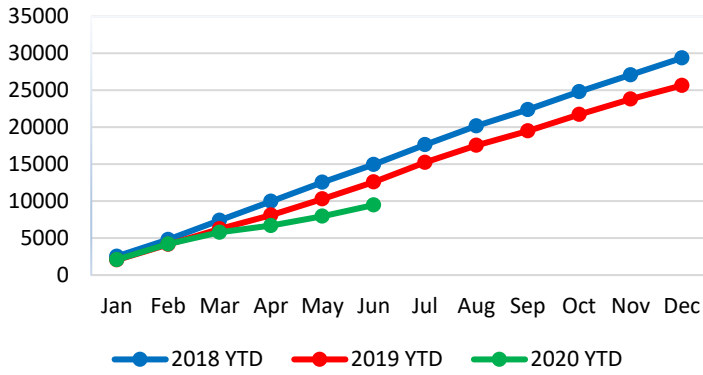
Assist Other Departments

Calls for Service

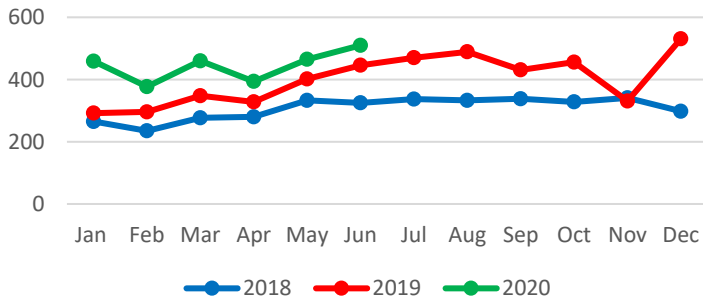
Calls for Service (Year to Date)



Officers handled 1519 calls for service during June. Year to date the department has handled 9474 calls for service, which is a -24.77% decrease compared to 2019.

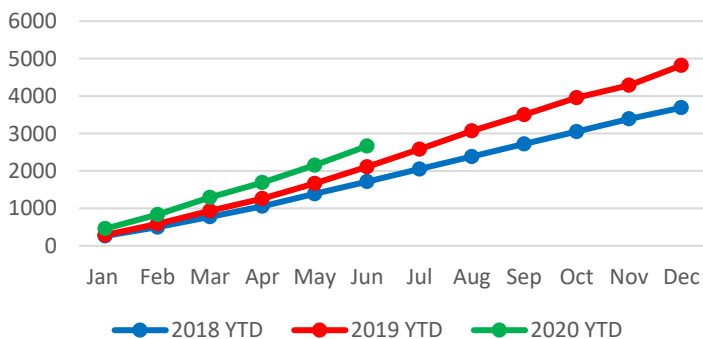
Time in Neighborhoods

Officers spent 510 hours in June in our neighborhoods. Officers spend time in our neighborhoods proactively patrolling, conducting traffic enforcement, and engaging with our residents. Year to date we have spent 2665 hours in our neighborhoods, which is a 26.18% increase compared to 2019.

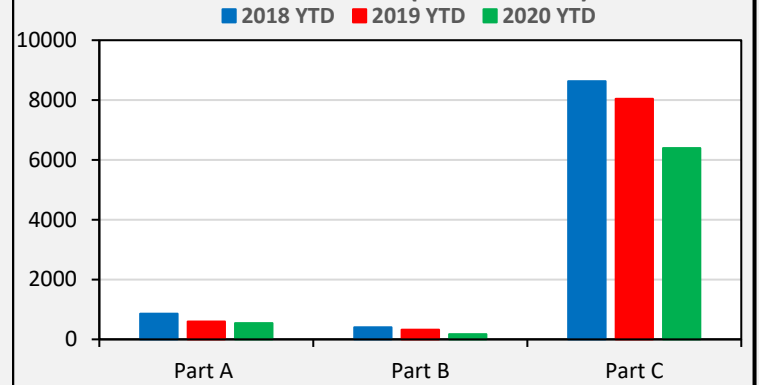
Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year to Date)



Crime and Service Statistics

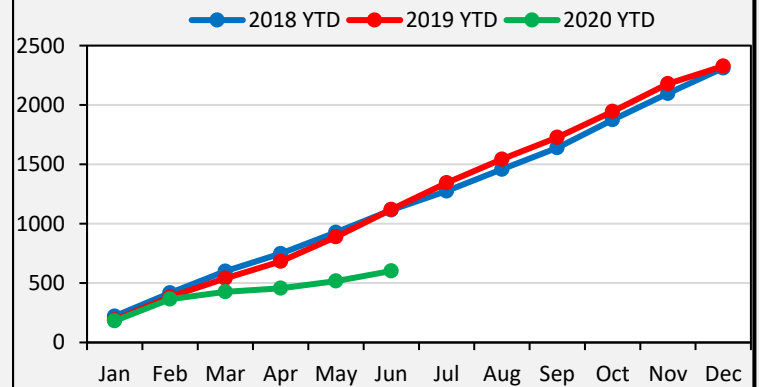
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.

Crime Statistics (Year to Date)



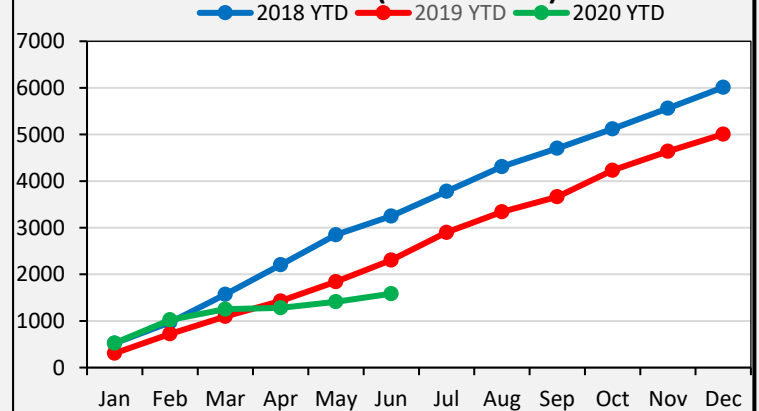
Year to date we have experienced a -9.40% decrease in Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -47.38% decrease in Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and a -20.52% decrease in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service-related incidents) compared to 2019.

During June, we handled 85 crashes. Year to date we have experienced a -46.25% decrease in traffic crashes compared to 2019.

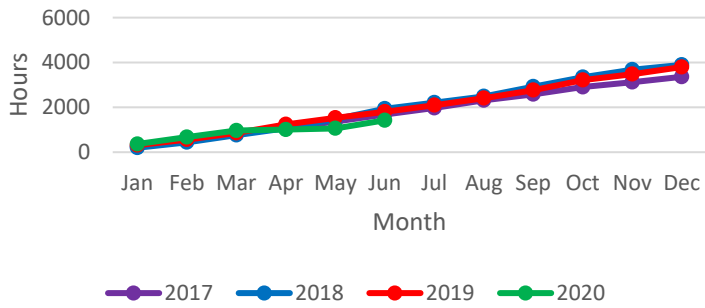
Citations (Year to Date)

(Cumulative Year to Date)**

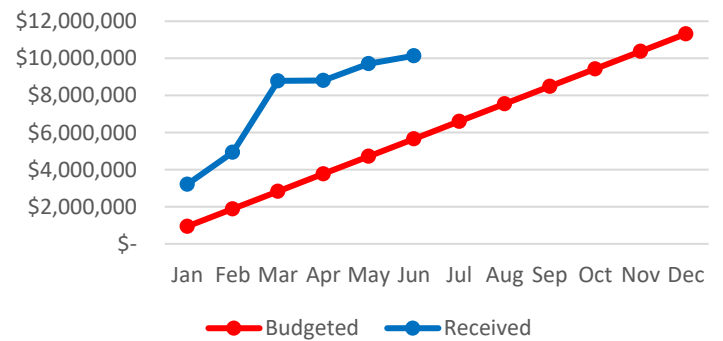


Officers worked a total of 361.75 hours of overtime in June. This is a cumulative year to date increase in overtime of 89.5 hours compared to this same time last year.

Financial Reports

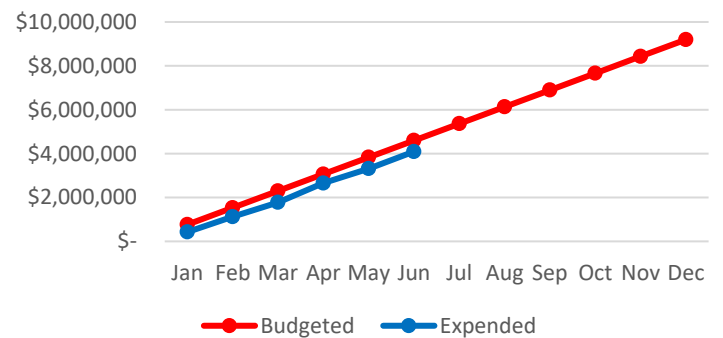
We continually analyze our department expenditures to ensure we remain within our approved budget, while delivering the best possible service to our community.
