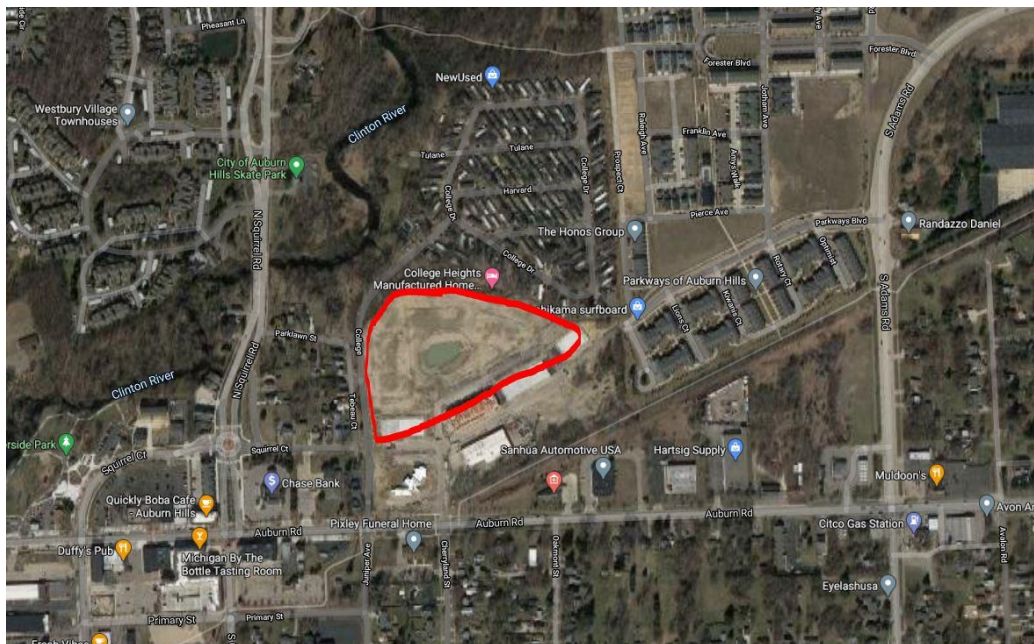

Malicious Destruction of Property

The Auburn Hills Police Department is currently investigating a malicious destruction of property incident that occurred at 3570 Fountain Circle, a new residential housing development in Auburn Hills. The incident occurred between February 23, 2021 at 5:30 pm and February 24, 2021 at 6:30 am. The property sustained significant damage, including water damage from broken plumbing fixtures, broken windows, paint damage, and glue damage. The damage is of significant value in materials and labor to have repaired, including a delay in getting these units ready for occupancy.

The new development is located on the north side of Auburn Rd. between N. Squirrel Rd. and Adams Rd. as depicted on the map in red.



Physical evidence from the scene is currently being processed. It would be in the best interest of those responsible to come forward now and contact the Auburn Hills Police Department.

A cash reward of \$1,000 is being offered for information that leads to the arrest and conviction of those responsible for this crime. Anyone with information regarding this incident is asked to contact the Auburn Hills Police Department at 248-370-9460. Callers can remain anonymous.
