Department's UAS Program

The Auburn Hills Department recently developed an Unmanned Aircraft System Program (referred to as a drone).

The department currently has one DJI Mavic Enterprise 2 aircraft and five Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) licensed remote pilots. The program has a multitude of uses which includes 3D crash and crime scene mapping, area searches, aerial views of major incidents, and supplying support to the fire department on fire scenes.

Operating While Intoxicated

On March 12, 2020 at 10:45 pm, Officer Dearing-Manning and Officer Riedy were dispatch to 835 Meadow Ridge Circle for a breaking and entering in progress.

The investigation revealed that the responsible individual broke a window to the apartment and fled the scene. Officer Dearing-Manning was able to find the responsible individual traveling southbound on Baldwin Road. Officer Dearing-Manning initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle and contacted the driver.

Officer Dearing-Manning could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. The driver submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which yielded a result of .174.

The driver was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County's Prosecutors Office authorized charges for Operating While Intoxicated High Blood Alcohol Content and Malicious Destruction of Property under \$200.00.

Possession of Controlled Substances

On March 26, 2020 at 02:04 am, Officer Sears was patrolling the parking lot of 2100 Featherstone Road.

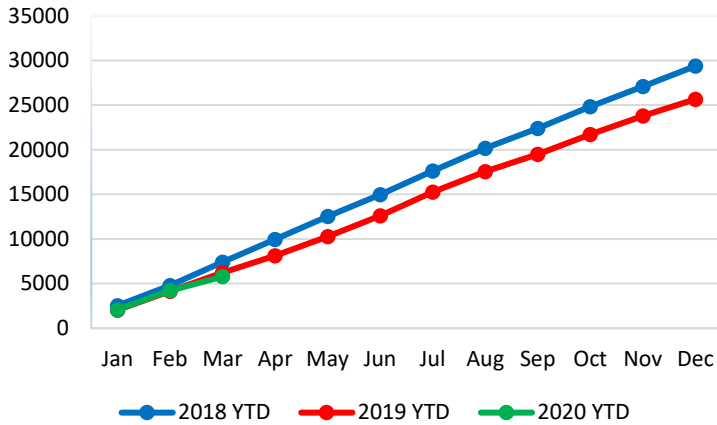
Officer Sears saw a female sitting inside of a parked vehicle and as he drove by, she ducked down to avoid being seen. Officer Sears contacted the occupant of the vehicle.

The investigation revealed that the subject was in possession of control substances. The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for Possession of Controlled Substances and Resisting and Obstructing.

Calls for Service

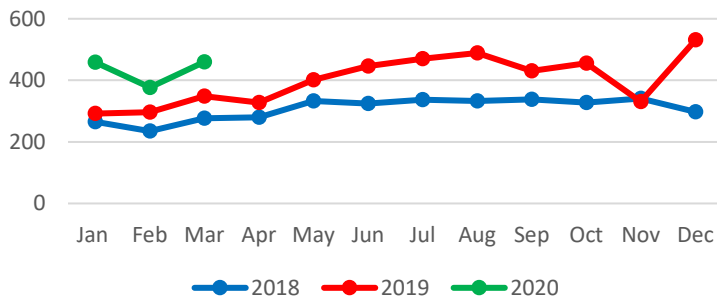
Calls for Service (Year to Date)



Officers handled 1581 calls for service during March. Year to date the department has handled 5782 calls for service, which is a -7.37% decrease compared to 2019.

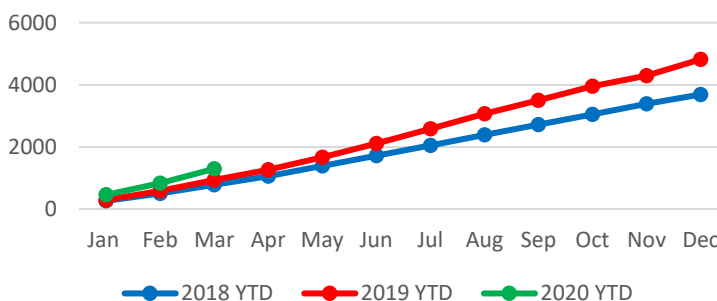
Time in Neighborhoods

Officers spent 460 hours in March in our neighborhoods. Officers spend time in our neighborhoods proactively patrolling, conducting traffic enforcement, and engaging with our residents. Year to date we have spent 1296 hours in our neighborhoods, which is a 38.46% increase compared to 2019.

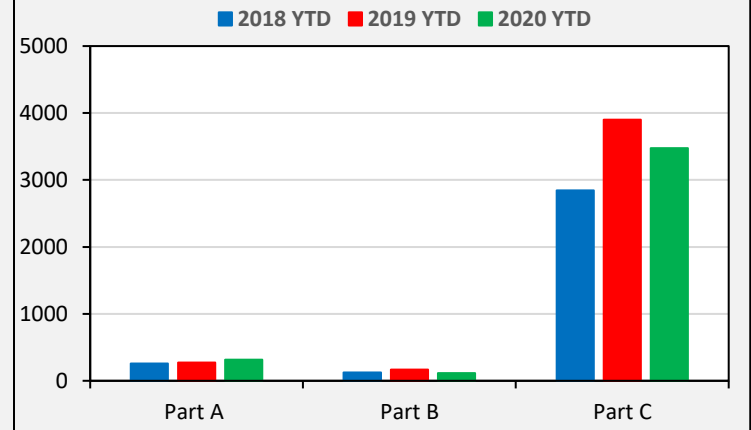
Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year to Date)



Crime and Service Statistics

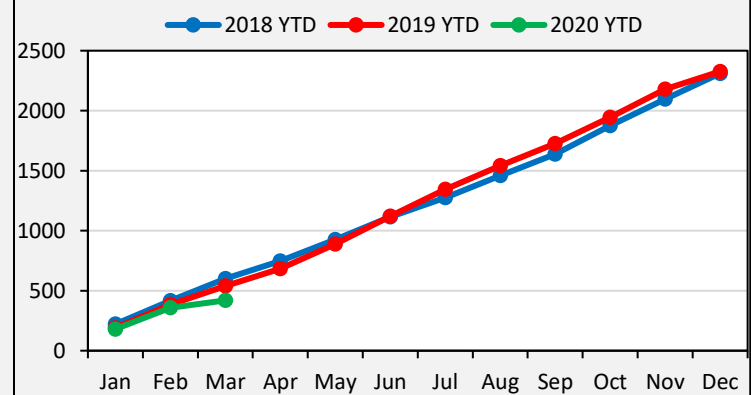
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.

Crime Statistics (Year to Date)



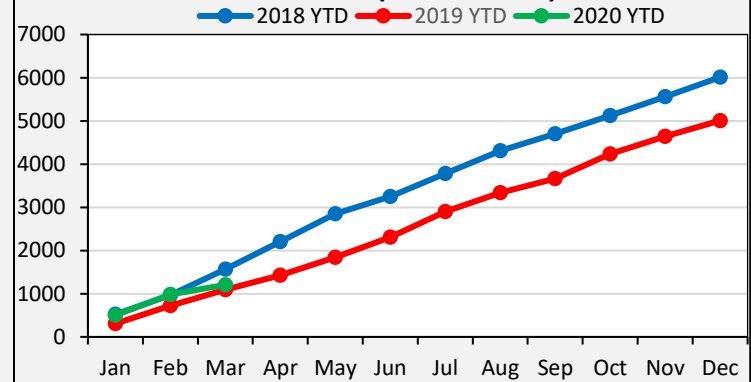
Year to date we have experienced a 15.87% increase in Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -30.54% decrease in Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and a -10.93% decrease in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service-related incidents) compared to 2019.

During March, we handled 61 crashes. Year to date we have experienced a -22.41% decrease in traffic crashes compared to 2019.

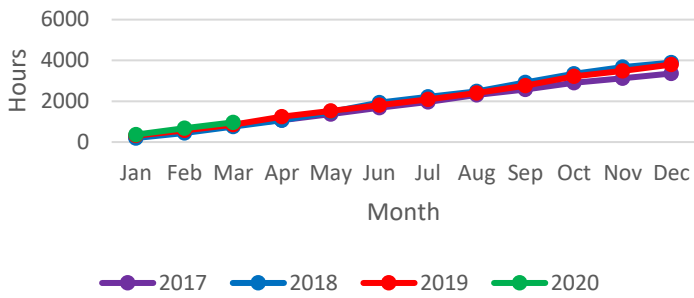
Citations (Year to Date)

Total Overtime Hours (Cumulative Year to Date)

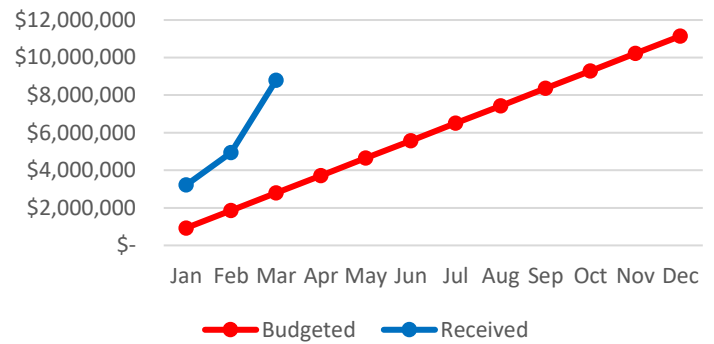


Officers worked a total of 291.75 hours of overtime in March. This is a cumulative year to date increase in overtime of 106.5 hours compared to this same time last year.

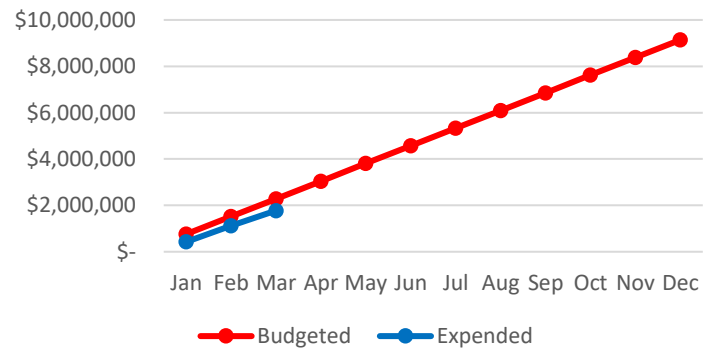
We continually analyze our department expenditures to ensure we remain within our approved budget, while delivering the best possible service to our community.

During March, we received \$3,848,685 in revenue. Year to date we have received \$8,783,771.

During March, we expended \$652,524. Year to date we have expended \$1,775,988 or 78% of our approved budget. We are currently \$509,028 under budget at the end of March 2020.
