### Breaking and Entering

On March 8, 2022, at 03:49 am, officers were dispatched to 2019 North Opdyke Road for a burglary alarm.

The investigation revealed that the business had been broken into and two cash registers were stolen. It was determined that the responsible subjects also broke into the business located at 3980 Baldwin Road. On March 8, 2022 two of the subjects were arrested in the city of Detroit. On March 9, 2022, the third suspect was arrested in the city of Detroit.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the three subjects with Breaking and Entering.

### Domestic Assault

On March 18, 2022, at 10:04 pm, officers were dispatched to 3230 Fivepoints Drive for a subject making suicidal statements.

The investigation revealed that a 40-year-old female from Auburn Hills, was assaulted by her husband. The suspect a 45-year old from Auburn Hills, was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the subject with Domestic Assault.

### Possession of Cocaine

On March 20, 2022, at 02:40 am, Officer Jackson was dispatched to the area of Allerton and Walton Boulevard for a vehicle that ran off the roadway.

The investigation revealed that the driver was operating the vehicle under the influence of alcohol and found to be in possession of Cocaine. The passenger in the vehicle was also found to be in possession of Cocaine. Both of the subjects were arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office charged the driver with Possession of Cocaine and Operating While Intoxicated. The passenger was charged with Possession of Cocaine.

## Felonious Assault

The investigation revealed that a 22-year-old from Roseville and a 22-year-old from Auburn Hills, were assaulted by an acquaintance. The suspect a 24-year-old male from Auburn Hills, was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail.

The Oakland County Prosecutor's Officer charged the subject with Assault with Intent to do Great Bodily Harm, Domestic Assault, and two counts of Felonious Assault.

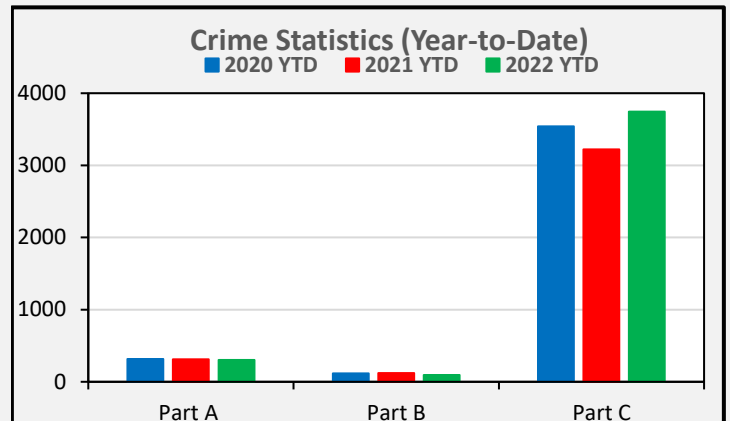
## Possession of Methamphetamine

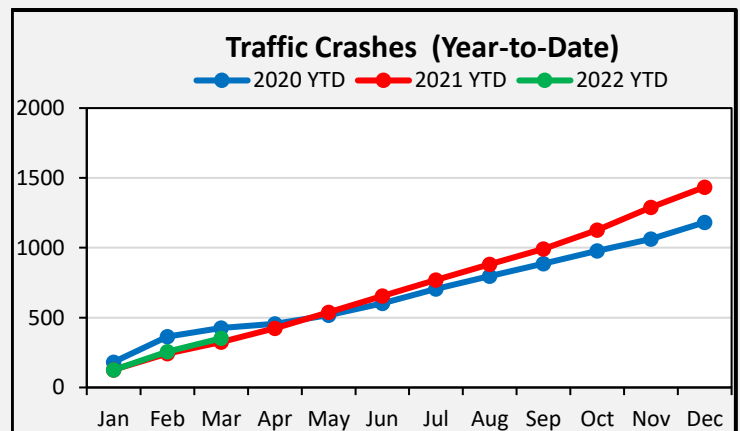
The arrestee was lodged at Oakland County Jail. This case was turned over to the Narcotics Enforcement Team (NET) for further investigation.

## Crime and Service Statistics

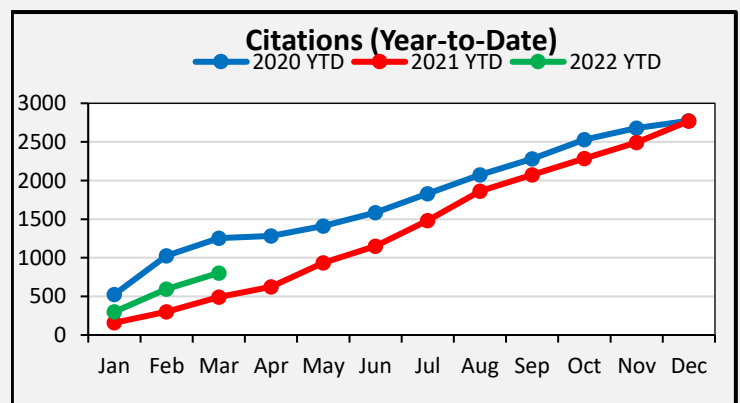
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.



Year to date we have experienced a -2.89% decrease in Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -19.33% decrease in Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and a 16.17% increase in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service-related incidents) compared to 2021.



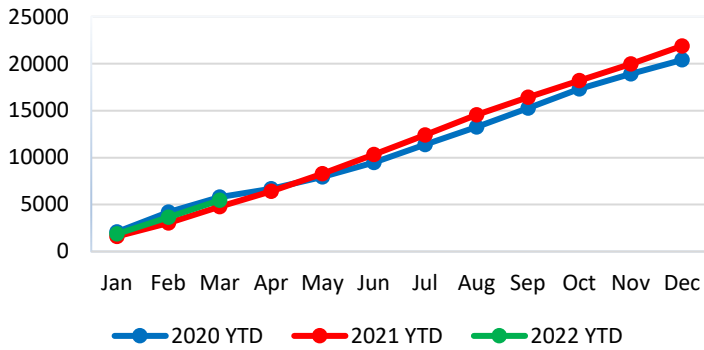
During March, we handled 95 crashes. Year to date we have experienced an 8.3% increase in traffic crashes compared to 2021.



Officers issued 211 citations in March 2022. Year to date we have experienced a 63% increase in citations issued compared to 2021.

## Calls for Service

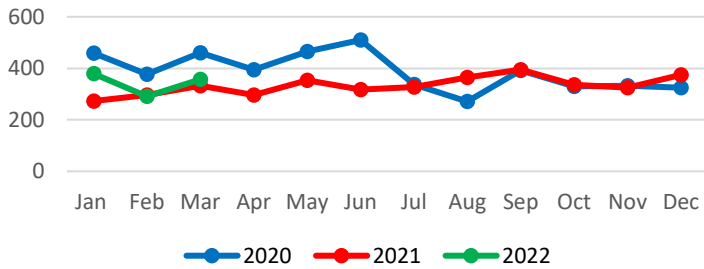
### Calls for Service (Year-to-Date)



Officers handled 1810 calls for service during March. Year to date the department has handled 5462 calls for service, which is an 14.5% increase compared to 2021.

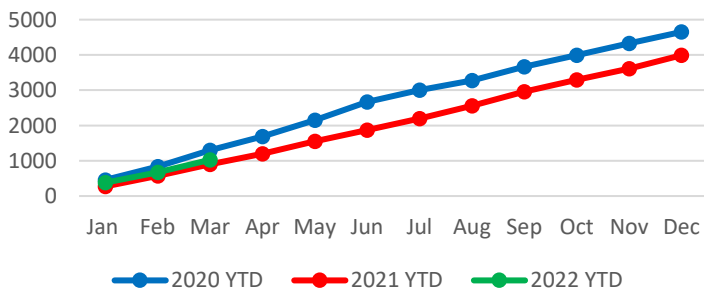
## Time in Neighborhoods

### Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year-to-Date)

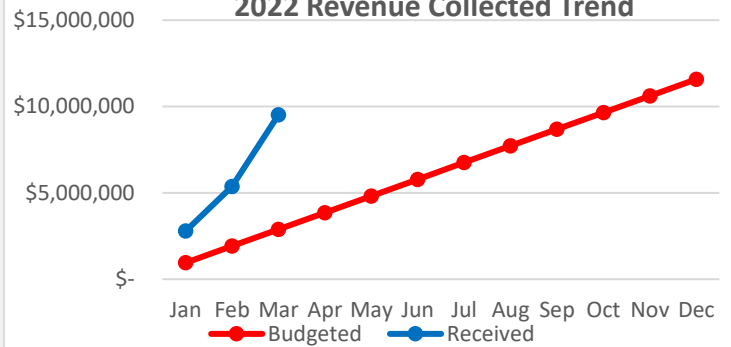


Year to date we have spent 1027 hours in our neighborhoods, which is an 14% increase compared to 2021.

## Financial Reports

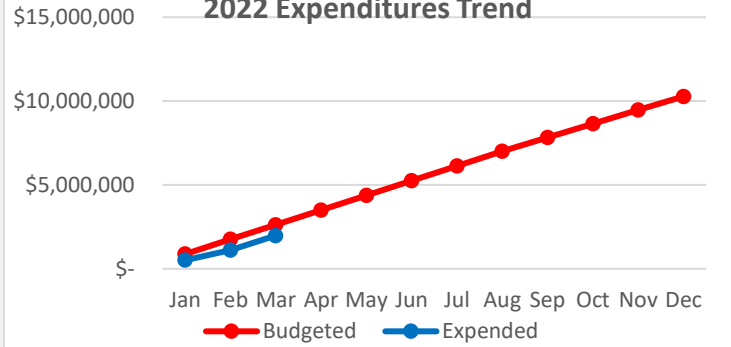
We continually analyze our department expenditures to ensure we remain within our approved budget, while delivering the best possible service to our community.

During March, we received \$4,145,249 in revenue. Year to date we have received \$9,516,086.

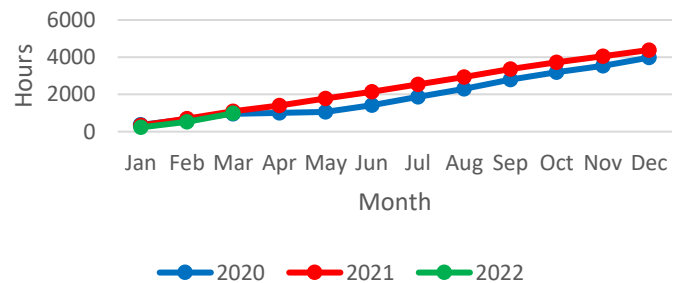
### 2022 Expenditures Trend



During March, we expended \$871,096. Year to date we have expended \$1,980,585 or 18% of our approved budget. We are currently \$648,439 under budget at the end of March 2022.

Officers worked a total of 468 hours of overtime in March. This is a cumulative year to date decrease in overtime of 105 hours compared to this same time last year.
