Retail Fraud

On May 10, 2020, at 12:50 pm, Officer Brehmer and Officer Halligan responded to 4150 Joslyn Road for a retail fraud incident that had just occurred.

The suspects fled the scene prior to the arrival of officers. The investigation revealed the suspects were also responsible for multiple thefts from Home Depot stores in Lake Orion and Rochester Hills.

The suspects were found and arrested by the Oakland County Sheriff's Department in the City of Pontiac. The suspects were lodged at the Oakland County Jail. The Oakland County Prosecutor's Office authorized charges for Retail Fraud 1st Degree.

Operating While Intoxicated

On May 25, 2020, at 7:10 pm, Officer Riedy was conducting traffic enforcement on I-75 and Featherstone. Officer Riedy conducted a traffic stop for a vehicle traveling 101 mph in a 70-mph speed zone.

Officer Riedy could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. The driver submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which yielded a result of .241.

The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail for Operating While Intoxicated and Possession of Cocaine.

Operating While Intoxicated

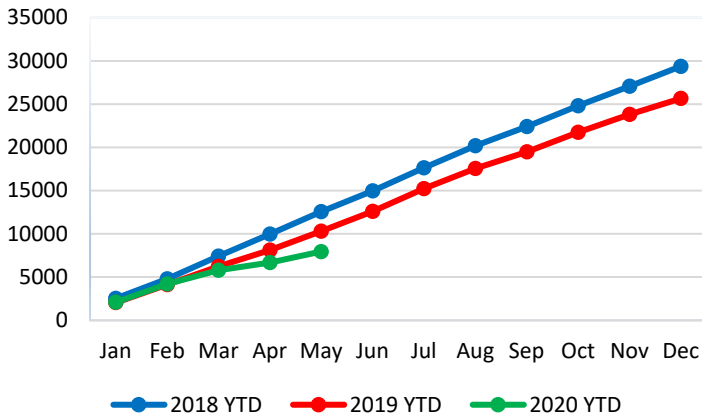
On May 26, 2020, at 03:55 am, officers responded to southbound I-75 and Baldwin Road for a single car crash where a vehicle struck the median wall.

Officers could smell an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from the driver's breath. The driver submitted to a Preliminary Breath Test (PBT), which yielded a result of .188.

The subject was arrested and lodged at the Oakland County Jail for Operating While Intoxicated.

Calls for Service

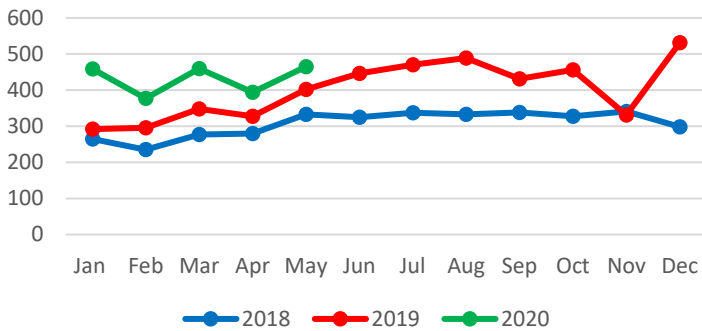
Calls for Service (Year to Date)



Officers handled 1265 calls for service during May. Year to date the department has handled 7955 calls for service, which is a -22.70% decrease compared to 2019.

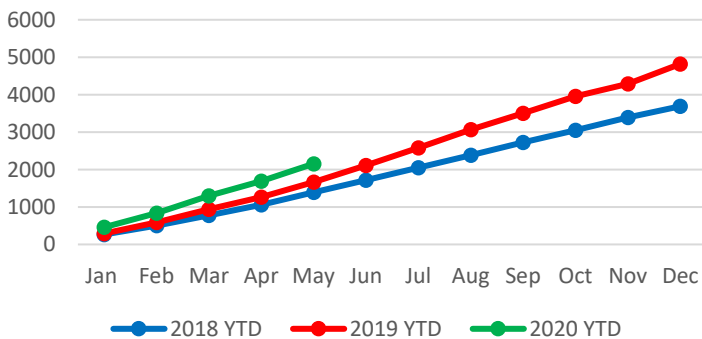
Time in Neighborhoods

Officers spent 465 hours in May in our neighborhoods. Officers spend time in our neighborhoods proactively patrolling, conducting traffic enforcement, and engaging with our residents. Year to date we have spent 2155 hours in our neighborhoods, which is a 29.35% increase compared to 2019.

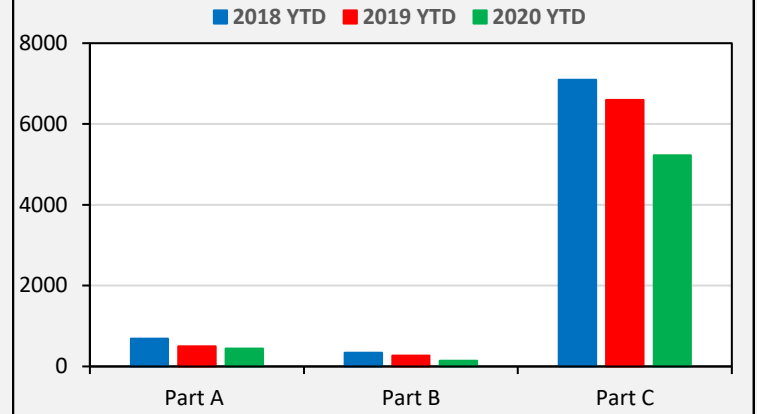
Cumulative Time in Neighborhoods (Year to Date)



Crime and Service Statistics

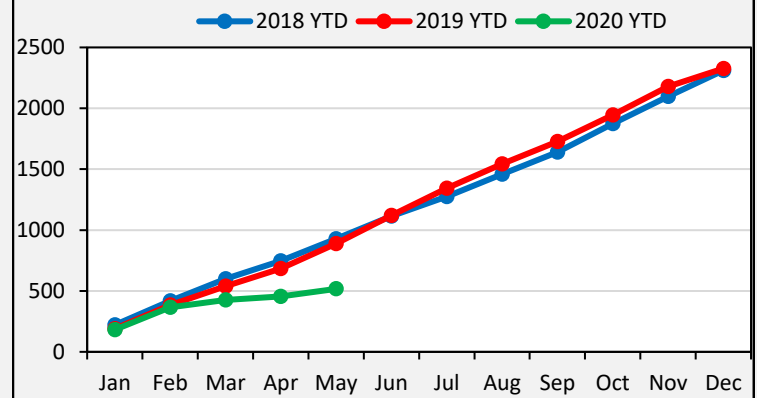
We continually strategize our responses and make the best use of the tools and personnel we have to produce the best possible outcomes.

Crime Statistics (Year to Date)



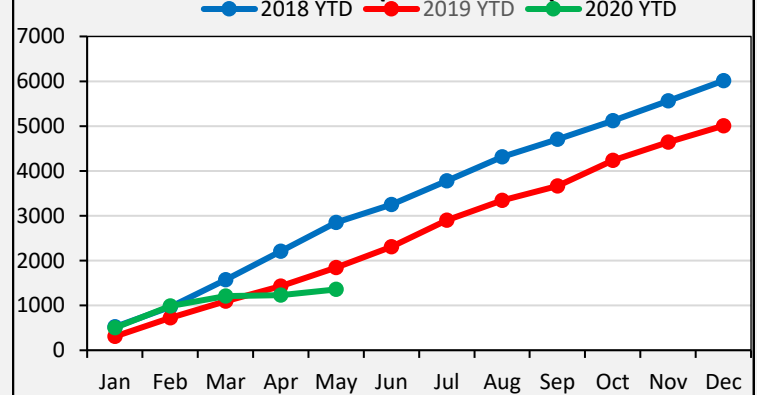
Year to date we have experienced a -12.20% decrease in Part A incidents (more serious offenses), a -47.19% decrease in Part B incidents (non-violent misdemeanors), and a -20.78% decrease in Part C incidents (misdemeanor and service-related incidents) compared to 2019.

During May, we handled 61 crashes. Year to date we have experienced a -41.84% decrease in traffic crashes compared to 2019.

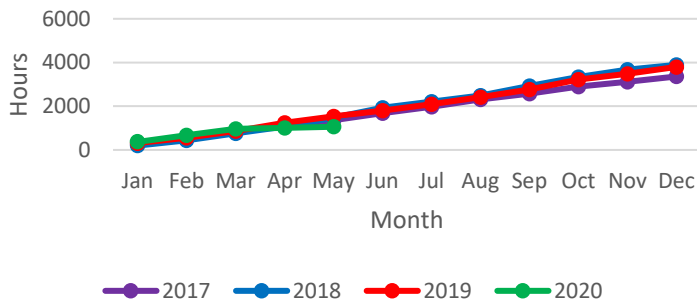
Citations (Year to Date)

Total Overtime Hours (Cumulative Year to Date)

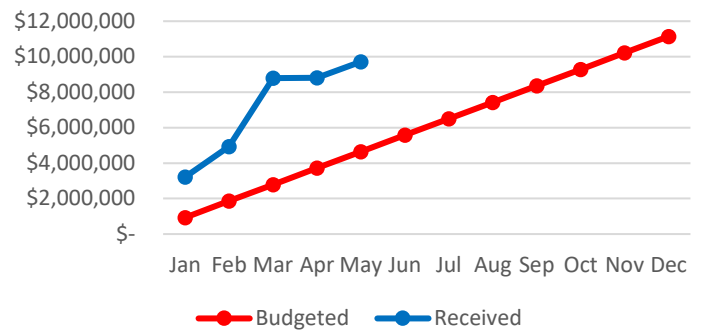


Officers worked a total of 53.5 hours of overtime in May. This is a cumulative year to date decrease in overtime of 236.75 hours compared to this same time last year.

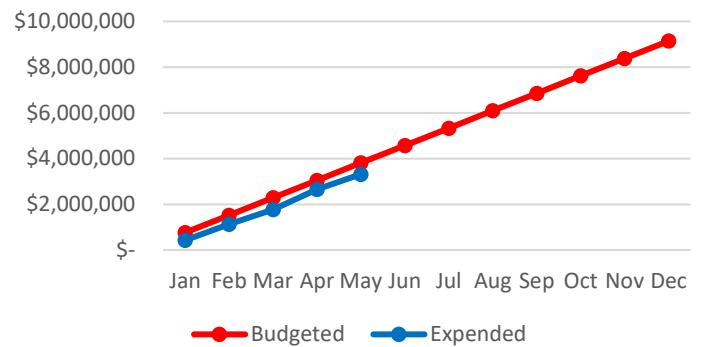
We continually analyze our department expenditures to ensure we remain within our approved budget, while delivering the best possible service to our community.

During May, we received \$448,426 in revenue. Year to date we have received \$9,714,028.

During May, we expended \$630,059. Year to date we have expended \$3,316,219 or 38% of our approved budget. We are currently \$492,141 under budget at the end of May 2020.
