Auburn Hills Declares a Snow Emergency

Due to the forecasted winter storm, the City of Auburn Hills has declared a snow emergency, effective tonight **Saturday January 4, 2014 at Midnight**. Due to the snow emergency, there will be no parking on the streets in residential neighborhoods after midnight tonight. Also, there will be no parking on Auburn Rd. in the downtown area after midnight tonight. This will allow city workers to clear the roads as quickly as possible. Vehicles parked in the roadway could be towed at the owner's expense. Abandoned vehicles along I-75, M-59 and major roadways will be towed.

Anyone who does not have to travel is asked to stay off of the roadways during the storm and subsequent snow removal operations. The public's cooperation as we deal with this winter storm is greatly appreciated.
