Auburn Hills Declares a Snow Emergency

Due to the forecasted winter storm expected tomorrow, the City of Auburn Hills has declared a snow emergency, effective **Wednesday, March 12, 2014 at 12:00 pm**. Due to the snow emergency, there will be no parking allowed on streets in residential neighborhoods. This will allow city workers to clear the roads as quickly as possible. Vehicles parked on residential streets could be towed at the owner's expense. Abandoned vehicles along I-75, M-59 and major roadways will be towed prior to the storm.

Anyone who does not have to travel is asked to stay off of the roadways during the storm and subsequent snow removal operations. The public's cooperation as we deal with this winter storm is greatly appreciated. An updated message will be sent when this snow emergency expires.
