On motion by Councilmember Whitworth and seconded by Councilmember Shropshire, Council unanimously approved the following minutes as circulated.

Mayor Banks explained the City has submitted and been approved for reimbursement for costs incurred on the Goggins Road Waste Excavation Project. He explained Resolution No. R2014-0012 approves the Agreement with EPD and authorizes the City Manager to execute and take all other action necessary to fully carry out the intent of the Agreement. On motion by Councilmember Whitworth and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Stone, Council unanimously approved Resolution No. R2014-0012.

On motion by Councilmember Shropshire and seconded by Councilmember Hightower, Council unanimously approved the appointment of Ms. Elaine Williams to a four year term on the Lamar County Elections Board.

Mayor Banks recognized Ms. Hedy Cauthen and Ms. Linda Akins of the Greenwood Cemetery Preservation Association. Ms. Cauthen addressed the Council and gave a report on the creation of the association and its mission to preserve, protect, and improve the Greenwood Cemetery. Ms. Cauthen reported on work done at the Gideon Barnes family gravesite, the improvements done at the main cemetery entrance, and future plans to fund the construction of brick columns and decorative fence along the road right of way.

Ms. Cauthen stated the association looks forward to working with the City Council and thanked the City for its support.

On motion by Councilmember Claxton and seconded by Councilmember Shropshire, Council unanimously approved the submittal of Elm Street, Grove Street, and a section of College Drive for the 2015 LMIG Paving Project.
