

**CITY OF BARNESVILLE
COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS
February 2, 2015**

Council met at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, February 2, 2015, in the Courtroom at 100 Mill Street in Barnesville, Georgia.

Mayor Peter L. Banks called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

ACTION TAKEN BY COUNCIL

On motion by Mayor Pro Tem Whitworth and seconded by Councilmember Hightower, Council unanimously approved the January 5, 2015 minutes as circulated.

Mayor Banks read a proclamation declaring February as Black History Month.

Mayor Banks stated that the City needed to recertify the City of Barnesville Ethics Ordinance and deliver it to the Georgia Municipal Association. On motion by Councilmember Stone and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Whitworth, Resolution No. R2015-0002 was unanimously approved.

Mayor Banks explained the City's Franchise Agreement with the Georgia Power Company was approaching expiration. Mayor Banks asked City Manager Roberts to read aloud the proposed Ordinance No. 543 which would renew the agreement. After the first reading, Mayor Banks stated the second reading and vote by Council would be on the March agenda.

Mayor Banks explained that the police department law enforcement software company had increased their user charge and proposed Ordinance No. 544 would increase police fines by \$5.00 to cover the increased cost. Mayor Banks asked City Manager Roberts to read aloud Ordinance No. 544. Mayor Banks stated the second reading and vote would be on the March agenda.

After no further business, Council adjourned at 6:15 p.m.
