**ACTION TAKEN BY COUNCIL**

Mayor Banks stated the purpose of the meeting was to have the second reading of Ordinance No. 588 to rezone properties fronting Holmes Street. The properties are further described as being Map B23-091, 092, 093, 094, 095, 096, 097, 098, 099, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, and 111 and are to be rezoned from R-2 Multifamily to R-1B Single Family Dwelling.

City Manager Turner first commended the City crews for all their hard work working on the storm repairs last night. Councilmember Claxton reported he had spoken with the Director of Utilities and Public Works Richard Vereen and he stated last night, they laid down at 3 a.m. and were back to work at 8:00 a.m. Councilmember Hightower thanked the employees for the work done and pointed out there were several new department heads and he asked if there would be a debriefing. City Manager Turner said he will talk with them on what went well and what needs to be improved. He added they all worked well together and the department heads were superb. He asked all to thank all of them if they see them. Councilmember McDaniel added kudos to Tim for being up all night with them.

City Manager Turner gave the second reading of Ordinance No. 588. Mayor Banks asked if there was any non-conforming use now. Mr. Turner stated there was none. On motion by Councilmember McDaniel and seconded by Councilmember Sims, Council unanimously adopted Ordinance No. 588 rezoning properties fronting Holmes Street as described and identified above.

Councilmember Hightower stated as the Council thanked the employees and crews for last night's work, he wanted to thank publicly City Clerk Tammy Folson for going beyond the call of duty in getting this meeting set up as they were the ones who decided to come back tonight without asking her, but she did it and did it with a smile.

After no further business and on motion by Councilmember Claxton and seconded by Councilmember Hightower, Council adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
