CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE ORDINANCE NO. 498

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY ORDINANCE 1995-372 SECTION 6 (B)
MAKING CHARITABLE OR RELIGIOUS SOLICITATION PERMITS GOOD FOR
THIRTY (30) DAYS INSTEAD OF NINETY (90) DAYS WITH ONLY ONE
(1) FUND RAISER PER MONTH

In order to promote the safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Bayou La Batre, Alabama, and to provide for the comfort and convenience of the inhabitants of said Municipality:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE, ALABAMA, that Section 6 of Ordinance No. 1995-372 be and is hereby deleted and replaced as follows:

SECTION 1. No solicitation permit granted by the information filed under Section 5 of City Ordinance 1995-372 shall be issued for longer than thirty (30) days, including Sunday's and local holidays.

- (A) The permit will allow for one (1) fund raiser during the thirty (30) days.
- (B) The purchaser of the solicitation permit will contact the Bayou La Batre Police Department to schedule the day of the fund raiser to make sure it does not conflict with another event on that date.
- (C) The Bayou Police Department will give a report to the City Clerk's Office of same.

Section 2: SEVERABILITY

If any article, section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by declaration of any Court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of remaining portions of this Ordinance and each article, section, sentence, clause, or phrase thereof irrespective of the fact that one or more articles, sections, sentences, clauses, or phrases be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 3: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING CODE SECTIONS AND ORDINANCES

All City Code Sections and Ordinances, or parts of City Code Sections and Ordinances, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, insofar as they conflict, are hereby repealed.

Section 4: EFFECT OF ORDINANCE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law. This Ordinance applies to property within the City Limits and Police Jurisdiction of the City of Bayou la Batre and shall be in full force and effect therein.
