

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-015

**AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE ALL HAZARD
COMPREHENSIVE EMERGENCY COORDINATION PLAN
FOR THE CITY OF BAYOU LA BATRE**

WHEREAS, the Federal government requires each state to have an emergency management plan as a method of insuring that there exists a coordination of effort between all levels of government to keep citizens and their property safe; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bayou La Batre is recognized by the State of Alabama as a political subdivision of the state that is responsible for emergency management; and

WHEREAS, a plan has been developed that ties the municipality into the framework of the local-state-federal effort to be used to guide city officials and community representatives during a major emergency or disaster to keep citizens and their property safe; and


WHEREAS, the State of Alabama requires that the local governing body adopt a All Hazard Comprehensive Emergency Coordination Plan for The City of Bayou La Batre that will satisfy all of the legal requirements in the State and Federal regulations; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE City of Bayou La Batre that the "All Hazard Comprehensive Emergency Coordination Plan" for the City of Bayou La Batre is hereby adopted by this resolution.
