Town of Bernalillo Department Spotlight: The Coronado Campground

The Coronado Campground is an Urban Campground within the historic Town Of Bernalillo located right off of Hwy 550 just behind Bosque Brewing and adjacent to the Coronado Historic Site. It sits on a bluff above the Rio Grande overlooking the Bosque, the foothills beyond, and finally the beautiful Sandia Mountains—a view treasured by the ancient Pueblos and Spanish conquistadors alike.

Each year we host thousands of guests from around the US and around the world. We have had guests from France, London, Germany, Canada, and Australia just to name a few. Most of these visitors are traveling through Albuquerque and choose to make the 14-mile trek to Bernalillo just to stay at the Coronado Campground.

The campground is also home to many different wild-life species including coyotes, rabbits, snakes, skunks, road runners, Canadian geese, and various other birds. If you're lucky, you may see eagles fishing the Rio Grande. We have also seen signs of bear, wild turkey, deer, and mountain lions. The campground offers several accommodations and amenities across two camping areas, the Main RV area

and the North area. The North area has tent and dry camp areas, a large shelter that can be used for several day use options, and fully-functioning restrooms. This area also has a trail that leads to a kayak launch for the Rio Grande. Please note that parking is limited, so there is a charge to park for any vehicle left on site. The north area is only open from March to November. The Main RV area is open all year round and has several water and electric sites (no sewer). The RV area is available for a 14 day max stay and can accommodate some very large RVs. Each site has its own casita shelter with a picnic table and fire-pit/grill.

Sites become very limited during our busy months, so making a reservation is highly recommended. You can always call Campground Director Phil Montoya for rates and/or any other questions you may have. You may also visit www.tobnm.gov to check site availability, pricing, rules and regulations, and make your own reservation.

Everyone is welcome at the Coronado Campground. Feel free to stop by the campground office and pick up a copy of the rules and regulations and start planning your next camping experience without leaving town.
