



## Town of Bernalillo Department Spotlight: Bernalillo Police Department

The Bernalillo Police Department (BPD) is comprised of 24 commissioned law enforcement personnel, including one detective, two school resource officers, one animal control officer, and two administrative staff. The police department proudly serves the community's law enforcement needs 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

Professional growth is an important aspect of law enforcement training, and BPD personnel have attended the following recent trainings:

- Interviews and Interrogations training
- ATF eTrace training to learn about an investigative tool used for tracking firearms that are checked into our evidence unit
- Property & Evidence Management class
- NM Law Enforcement Conference
- Instructor Development training
- Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE)
- Search Warrant training
- Officer Survival McGrane training

### Departmental Updates

- Deployed 4 new units to patrol
- Responded to a hoax threat at Bernalillo High School on February 16. BPD officers and surrounding agencies immediately responded and entered the school to ensure safety
- Completed/submitted all required training hours for the New Mexico Law Enforcement Academy (NMLEA)
- Completed firearms qualification report for 2022
- Renewed commissions in Sandoval County for all officers
- Participated in the Special Olympics
- Hired an additional part-time animal control officer
- Working with Street Cat Hub through their Trap, Neuter, Release (TNR) program for different areas throughout town
- Pet registration – Any residents who are new to the town are encouraged to register their pets

(CAR & TRUCK LOADS ONLY - vehicles pulling trailers will NOT be allowed to dump in the dumpsters and will be redirected to the landfill.)

Due to landfill regulations, the Town WILL NOT be able to accept the following: Refrigerators, Freezers, Ice Makers, Tires, Large Drums, Medical Waste, Paint, Asbestos Materials, Contaminated Soil, Hazardous Waste-Liquid, Batteries, or Railroad Ties, and TV's.
