The Municipal Officers Electoral Board shall meet on Wednesday, January 20, 2021, at 7:00 a.m. In accordance with Public Act 101-0640 and Section 6 of Executive Order 2020-07, as amended and extended, most recently by Executive Order 2021-1, the meeting of the Municipal Officers Electoral Board will be held both remotely and in person based on the Gubernatorial Disaster Declaration and the President of the Village of Frankfort determining that a full in-person meeting is not practical or prudent. Members of the public will be able to attend the meeting in person in the Village Board Room, Village Administration Building, 432 W. Nebraska St. Frankfort, IL 60423. The Village will enforce any capacity restrictions in effect due to any applicable Gubernatorial Executive Order.
