The meeting was called to order by Mayor Hanna at 6:30 PM.

No finance charges on this grant – close To free money. (2). Sewer Project – bids open 1/28/2020. (3). CBGD – another month – 1-1/2 months before proposals are due. (4). Wants to recognize rescuers who saved lives of child and elder in the Trailer fire on January 4, 2020.

Motion was made by Council Member Bailey and seconded by Council Member Stone to enter into executive session. Motion carried unanimously.


Motion was made by Council Member Stone and seconded by Council Member Poston to enter back into open session. Motion carried unanimously.
