The City Clerk reported that the Media was notified by email and the agenda was posted at City Hall on Monday April 27, 2020.

The City Administrator reported the following: (1) reported that he is sending out email mostly from Florence County and SC DHEC concerning the OVID-19, it looks like Florence County is flattening the curve on COV:ID-19 and we will be setting up with ZOOM for electronic meetings if COVID-19 continues. (2) City Hall is closed except on Mondays with drive thru service. We will gradually reopen the office in steps. (3) The Governors update today says there will be monies available for Cities and Towns who will need assistance from the COVID-19. Council Member Arthurs asked if this money is free. Administrator stated free.

Council Reports: Council Member Bailey reported that he and Council member Poston helped with a food drive on Friday May 24, and it was a great success. And there will be a few more planned in the weeks ahead.


The Mayor Reported the following: (1) The City will recognize the Johnsonville High School Seniors, Mr. Smith and David Mace are working on something really nice for this occasion. (2) Mayor Hanna stated that he thinks what was done with the food drive is wonderful and is a great thing but we as council

need to be able to keep things with other organizations separate from the City so that there is no misrepresentation of the City.

Motion was made by Council Member Bailey and seconded by Council Member Poston to adjourn the meeting. **Motion carried unanimously**
