Documentation needed to apply (in addition to the application):

- A current certificate or verification letter of free or reduced school lunch

OR

- A copy of the parent's / guardian's 2021 income tax summary sheet showing the total annual income and number of dependents (social security number should be blacked out prior to submitting the form)

(The child that is listed on the scholarship app must be listed as a dependent on the income tax summary page)

Scholarship Application Guidelines:

- Applications must be completely filled out and have all supporting documentation
- Applications must be turned in at the Central Park Performing Arts Center or emailed to CPPAC@largo.com
- Submitting a scholarship application does not reserve a space for your child in the class.
- Scholarships will be offered until all scholarship funds are distributed or the class is full.
- If approved for a scholarship, the family will be responsible for paying the full balance of the class by September 17 at 5pm.
- A City of Largo Recreation, Parks and Arts Membership Card is required to register for the class. This fee is not covered under the scholarship funding.
