

City of Largo Summer Camp Scholarship Application 2023

Scholarship Application Guidelines

- Applications will be accepted beginning on February 1st.
- Applications may be turned in at the Southwest Recreation Center or the Highland Recreation Center.
- Applications must have all supporting documentation. Applications submitted without the proper documentation will be delayed and funds will not be held.
 - **Copy of the parent/guardian 2022 Income Tax Summary sheet** showing the total annual income and number of dependents (social security numbers should be blacked out prior to submitting the form) is required. No other years will be accepted.
 - **Copy of proof of residency** (parents driver's license or utility bill) is required.
- The child that is listed on the scholarship application **must** be listed as a dependent on the Income Tax Summary page submitted.
- Income verification brackets are based on the number of dependents listed on the Income Tax Summary page so please be sure this matches your application. Income brackets are available on the reverse side.
- Scholarships will be awarded in the order they are received, and approval notifications will begin in February.
- Families will be notified via email after their scholarship application has been reviewed.

Scholarship Registration/Attendance Requirements *Initial next to each one*

I understand that being awarded a scholarship does not guarantee my child a space in camp. Once approved, anyone that is awarded a scholarship must register and make their first payment within **two weeks** of receiving an acceptance letter in order to secure their scholarship funding. Resident registration begins February 1st and non-resident begins February 15th.

I understand that my child may not miss more than one day per week that they are registered for

I understand that a physicians note or legal documentation is required for any absences that exceed the one day per week.

I understand that my child should be in camp each day from 9a-2p (can attend as early as 7a and as late as 4p) Aftercare is available from 4-6p for an additional cost.

I understand that if the scholarship requirements are not met, my child will not be eligible for a scholarship in future camp years.
