

City of Manassas Transportation Master Plan Bike Lane Pilot

As part of the City's annual repaving program, some existing bike routes received upgraded pavement markings that meet current national standards and best practices. Those upgrades are in accordance with the current Bikeway and Pedestrian Trail System Master Plan (2007) and the draft [Transportation Master Plan](#) (2019). Upgraded pavement markings are a routine component of all street repaving projects. Streets with upgraded marking are:

- Richmond Avenue from Liberia Avenue to Fairview Avenue (bike lanes)
- Godwin Drive from Hastings Drive to Cloverhill Road (upgraded bike lanes)
- Cloverhill Road from Godwin Drive to Hastings Drive (bike lanes)
- Portner Avenue from Breeden Avenue to Liberia Avenue (share-the road "sharrow" markings)

These upgraded bike routes also serve as pilot facilities as part of the development of the City's first Transportation Master Plan. Residents are encouraged to ride the new lanes and provide feedback to Chloe Delhomme at cdelhomme@manassasva.gov. Additional bike facilities will be upgraded annually after repaving.
