



To the Residents of the City of Milan:

Currently, City Hall is without phone service. We are unable to provide you with an estimated time of power restoration or take reports of wires down:

If you need to report wires down, call 911.

Your City Officials are aware of the situation throughout town. The Department of Public Works, Fire Department and Police Department are working as quickly as possible to clear roadways and secure downed wires. We ask that you remain indoors as much as possible and allow City crews and DTE crews to address the situation. If you must leave your residence for any reason, be conscious of your surroundings: **DO NOT** approach any downed wires. Per DTE Energy: “Please be safe and remember to stay at least 25 feet from any downed power lines – assume they are live and dangerous.”

With widespread power outages, if you are in need of a warm place to gather, you are welcome at The Center (45 Neckel Court).

When it is safe to do so, please collect fallen branches and place them in the greenbelt; DPW crews will be around town as they are able to collect. Please do **NOT** place fallen branches in the street.

Please be patient as this is a widespread event; all crews are working as quickly as possible.
