

**MINUTES OF A WORK SESSION OF THE MILAN CITY COUNCIL

Mayor Hamden called the work session to order at 6:47 p.m.

A workshop was held to discuss new Lead and Copper Rules set by MDEQ. OHM Engineers Steve Warren and Greg Marker provided a brief history on the Lead ban from fixtures and the Safe Water Drinking Act. Timelines on an inventory of existing lead, sampling requirements and private property replacement of lead was discussed. Mr. Warren provided the estimated cost of \$3,500.00 each to the city for replacement of private service lines with a total potential cost of \$350, 000.00. A desktop research on private water services is due by January 1, 2020. Replacements will start January 1, 2021 and completion of all replacement is required by January 1, 2025. Further guidance will be provided as sampling protocol is updated.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Austin Blaine expressed his concerns of entering private property for construction of replacements seem to violate the Fourth amendment of the Constitution.
