New Concert Series features Nationally-Recognized Artists in Quaint Historic Setting

July 28, 2021, Northglenn, CO – The historic Stonehocker Farmhouse will be the gathering spot for Northglenn’s inaugural Porch Concert Series on the first Thursday of August, September and October. The series will feature three singer/songwriters performing on the home’s porch. Audience-goers will enjoy an intimate setting with a maximum of 75 people gathered on the lawn. Following a more relaxed “house concert” feel, the series strives to set the stage for an enjoyable outdoor evening performance.

The Stonehocker Farmhouse, located at 10950 Fox Run Parkway, was added to the National Register of Historic Places and the State Register of Historic Properties in 1998. Also referred to as the Thede Farmhouse, the building was constructed in 1903 and sits on the eastern edge of the city.
