Dumpster Days Open to Northglenn Residents *Two Days in June to Get Rid of Large Items*

Northglenn, CO – The City of Northglenn is hosting its inaugural Dumpster Days in June. These free opportunities allow city residents to conveniently clear up their garage, toss out old furniture and dispose of many other items that can't fit in a trash cart.

Two Dumpster Days will be held in June, one for residents on each side of the city:

- **Residents living on the east side of Interstate 25:** Sat., June 8, 8 a.m.-4 p.m., Maintenance & Operations Facility, 12301 Claude Court
- **Residents on the west side of I-25:** Sat., June 22, 8 a.m.-4 p.m., north side of Northwest Open Space, West 112th Avenue and Ranch Drive

Dumpster Days are open to all Northglenn residents, so proof of residency is necessary, such as a driver's license or current utility bill with photo identification. Only one pickup or single-axle trailer per residence, please. This service is not open to businesses.

Items that are not allowed include:

- Tires
- Concrete
- Electronics
- Wet paint
- Building materials
- Dirt and sod
- Chemicals
- Mattresses and box springs
- Appliances with Freon

The city sees this as a great way to help residents who have limited options to discard of large or bulk items.

“Participants either don’t have the means to take it to the dump, or they’ve exhausted their free special pickups and they need some additional resources to get rid of unwanted materials,” said Neighborhood Services Supervisor Tom Carlson.
