This CARA year-round recreational team offers high-quality coaching for all abilities. The team's focus is on technique, teamwork, competition and of course, fun! Practice revolves around the four competitive strokes, along with starts and turns.

A swimming assessment is necessary. Swimmers must be able to complete 25 yards doing two out of the four major strokes. For the other two strokes, swimmers must show working knowledge.

“We want our team members to become better swimmers,” said Coach Victoria Budzien. “But more importantly, we want them to learn skills and habits that will help them in everyday life.”

The time commitment is three practices during the week for one hour at the Northglenn Recreation Center, 11801 Community Center Drive. Meets take place on a single day on select weekends in the Denver area.
