Report of Shots Fired in Northglenn Sunday Night

Oct. 10, 2022, Northglenn, CO – Last night at approximately 9:08 p.m., Northglenn Police Department responded to the 11100 block of Huron Street on a report of shots fired. A nearby resident called to report a male party on their property saying he had been shot.

Upon arrival, officers discovered there had been an exchange of gunfire between at least two individuals. An 18-year-old male was shot. Officers rendered medical aid and he was soon transported to a local area hospital with non-life-threatening injuries.

The individual initially reported to police he was carjacked, but later became uncooperative and provided no further information. A second male fled the scene.

At this time there is no threat to the public. No arrests have been made.
