



ROLL-OFF RENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The container remains the property of the City of Northglenn, Solid Waste Division; however, the customer acknowledges the care, custody and control of the container while at the customer's location. The customer further accepts responsibility for all loss or damage to property arising out of use or possession of the container (except normal wear and tear) and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Northglenn against all claims, damages and suits for injury or death to persons or damage to property arising out of use or possession of the container. Container access must be unobstructed for delivery and pickup. Container will be placed in the street adjacent to the requesting property owner's property. Containers will not be placed in driveways.

Please Note: WASTE MATERIAL SHALL NOT EXCEED THE TOP OF THE CONTAINER
AND SHALL NOT EXCEED 12 TONS

ACCEPTABLE WASTE MATERIALS include but are not limited to: construction materials including lumber, drywall, roofing materials, concrete, asphalt, rock, sand, gravel and brick. Household trash, furniture, metal, carpeting, and yard waste as permitted by city ordinance are also acceptable.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS include mattresses, bedsprings, boxsprings, tires, appliances containing Freon, electronic waste including but not limited to: televisions, DVD/VCR equipment, video game consoles, computers and peripherals, radios, stereos, etc. Medical or biological wastes, radioactive materials, corrosive, flammable, explosive, toxic or hazardous materials as defined by Federal and State Law are unacceptable. Other materials prohibited by city ordinance are also not allowed. Placement of prohibited materials will result in the customer being fully liable for costs incurred relating to cleanup and disposal of these items.
