Re-certify Your Business for State Enterprise Zone Credits

Make sure your business pre-certifies for Enterprise Zone state income tax credits in 2022.

Most city businesses can earn these credits when purchasing furniture, fixtures, and equipment (FFE), hiring new employees, offering formalized training, or providing health insurance. However, to qualify you must **pre-certify each year**, even if you have pre-certified in the past. To pre-certify for 2022 go to [Enterprise Zone](#).
