Free Landfill Day

Sat., May 12, 7 a.m.-2 p.m., Tower Road Landfill, 88th Avenue, just east of Tower Road, Commerce City

Northglenn residents – this is your free chance to dispose of items that are too large to fit in your trash cart!

Rules include:

- Only one load per residence
- All loads must be covered
- Proof of residency such as a driver's license or current utility bill is required
- Mattresses and box springs cost \$30 each to drop off
- People bringing a pickup truck or trailer face a gate charge plus taxes and fees if they have more than five cubic yards of materials
- A safety vest must be worn when unloading. They are provided at the landfill entrance.

Electronics, tires, car batteries, appliances with Freon, fluorescent bulbs and hazardous liquids or materials are NOT accepted. Call 303-450-4004 weekdays, 7 a.m.-3:30 p.m., for help with these items or for more about free landfill day.
