### **Comment Needed on 112<sup>th</sup> Station Area Plan**

*FasTracks Station Scheduled to Open in 2018*

(Northglenn, CO) The N-Line of the RTD FasTracks commuter rail line will launch in 2018, and the cities of Northglenn and Thornton are looking for resident feedback to make sure they're ready.

The draft 112th Avenue Station Area Master Plan is available for public review online at [www.northglennstation.org](http://www.northglennstation.org).

People who live, work and attend school in the area are urged to look at the draft of the plan and provide feedback, but comments from all residents and potential station users are welcome.

The plan will guide land use and transportation infrastructure in the area to make sure it supports the station while providing a vibrant, walkable and mixed-use community. The goal is to create a hub that connects the 112<sup>th</sup> Ave. station to local neighborhoods.

Over the past year, the two cities have hosted multiple public and stakeholder meetings and taken in feedback to put together this draft.

Comments will be accepted until Jan. 7, 2017.
