Northglenn, CO – The City of Northglenn is holding the first of three open houses to discuss future plans for Northwest Open Space, located south of West 112<sup>th</sup> Avenue off of Ranch Drive.

The meeting will be held 5:30-7:30 p.m. Wednesday, Jan. 11, at the Northglenn Senior Center, 11801 Community Center Drive.

City residents, neighbors, athletic teams and other interested users are welcome to come discuss needs for the space and to give feedback on a few initial concept designs. Please stop in at any time during the open house!

The city intends to add permanent restroom facilities, concessions, shelters, and other site amenities. Additionally, the city will be addressing drainage, field orientation and the need for additional parking and trail improvements throughout the space. Your input and feedback are an important part of the design process.

The Oscar Arnold Nature Area will be maintained in its natural state.
