Electronic Disposal and Shred Event, Rescheduled for August 27

(Northglenn, CO) The 4th Annual Electronic Disposal and Shred Event originally scheduled in April, will be held Saturday, August 27, from 8 a.m. to noon at the Northglenn Marketplace, Interstate 25 and 104th Avenue.

Almost all electronics are accepted for disposal free of charge except some televisions and monitors. Fees are \$5 for CRT-computer monitors, and \$30 for CRT-tube television sets. Flat monitors, television sets and all other electronics are disposed of free of charge.

Gather personal and sensitive documents in a box or bag and bring them in to be shredded. Shredding keeps your personal information safe and helps prevent identity theft and fraud.

“Recycling electronics and shredding documents can be a hassle,” said Northglenn Officer Scott McNeilly. “This way is easy and convenient, and you can be assured that your old electronics and documents will be processed safely and securely.”

Please note that old medications will NOT be accepted.
