### **City Hall Closed for Martin Luther King Jr. Day**

Trash will be picked up as normal.

**Jan. 6, 2017** – Northglenn City Hall will be closed on Monday, Jan. 16, in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

Residents who wish to drop off utility payments may do so at the drop-off box in front of the building, 11701 Community Center Drive. City Hall will reopen at 8 a.m. Tuesday, Jan. 17.

The Northglenn Recreation Center and Northglenn Senior Center will still be open that day, and all regularly scheduled activities will take place as normal.

Trash will be collected as normal. Residents are reminded to have all their trash placed in carts and out to the curb by 7 a.m. the day of pickup.

The regularly-scheduled City Council study session will not be held that night.
