### **Petition Season for Northglenn Council Candidates**

**Nomination Petitions Available Aug. 7; Must be Submitted by Aug. 28**

**July 31, 2017** – Northglenn voters will elect a mayor and one council member from each of the city's four wards at the regular municipal election on Nov. 7, 2017. Candidates are nominated by petition. The City Clerk provides petition forms.

There are also filing requirements that must be met when individuals declare their candidacy and either accept a contribution or spend money in support of their candidacy.

#### **Council Candidate Calendar**

Below are important dates for running for City Council:

Aug. 7: Nomination petition forms are available for pick up in the City Clerk's Office in City Hall, 11701 Community Center Drive.

Aug. 8–28: Nomination petitions may be circulated. Petitions must be signed by at least 25 registered voters living within the candidate's ward for council member positions or by at least 25 registered voters living in Northglenn for mayoral candidates.

Aug. 28: Nomination petitions must be submitted to the City Clerk's Office by 5 p.m. on Monday, Aug. 28.
