The City of Northglenn has scholarships for recreation programs for Northglenn residents. Applications are accepted at any time.

Also, a limited number of scholarships are available just for Summer Day Camp through the Northglenn Community Foundation. Awards may cover up to 75 percent of the total cost. Applications for day camp scholarships are due by March 31.

Eligibility for all scholarships is based on household income. Income documentation must be included with the application.
