The matter having come before the Court upon *Plaintiff's Emergency Motion for Temporary Restraining Order, Order of Preliminary Injunction, and Order to Show Cause*, the Court having ordered a show cause hearing regarding preliminary injunction on Wednesday, December 11, 2019, and the Parties having stipulated to the relief set forth herein;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. On November 20, 2019, Defendant Mayor Deidre Waterman announced that the City would immediately begin accepting provisioning center permit applications, and that the application window would close on December 10, 2019. This application window for provisioning center permit applications is ~~declared~~ moot.
2. The effective application window for the City's acceptance of provisioning center applications shall be from January 6, 2020 to January 27, 2020, as previously announced by Defendant Interim City Clerk Garland Doyle on November 21, 2019.
3. All other issues raised by the Parties shall be preserved for the Parties to attempt to resolve among themselves or to submit to the Court for a ruling.
