

Phoenix roof update:



On December 11, 2021 the tensile roof on the Phoenix Amphitheater was torn by a storm.

The City of Pontiac immediately called Lee Industrial to remove large sections of the roof that were a danger to both the public and the structure.

An insurance claim has been filed and the City is moving through that process.

Accessing the roof with the needed equipment to remove the remaining parts of the fabric requires structural investigation to determine the correct path that equipment could take. In addition, the City has engaged in a bid process to obtain the best value for removing the remaining pieces of fabric.

The structural review and the bid process took several weeks each.

The City is close to making a final decision on a company to remove the remaining pieces of fabric.

It is anticipated that the selection and removal of the final fabric will be complete by the middle of March.

The cleanup and structural inspection requires a large piece of equipment to be craned up on the roof, it will be sat on ½ inch thick plates that also have to be craned in place for the equipment to drive on. Then the removal can take place along with an additional Structural Inspection.
