SECTION 3-104

A complaint against a law enforcement officer, alleging the use of excessive force in the execution of his/her duties, may not be investigated unless the complaint is sworn to by the aggrieved person, a member of the aggrieved person's immediate family, by any person present at the alleged incident, someone who has a video recording of the incident, that, to the individual's knowledge, is unaltered, or by the parent or guardian in the case of a minor child. An investigation which could lead to disciplinary action under this subtitle for excessive force may not be initiated and an action may not be taken unless the complaint is filed within 366 days of the alleged excessive force incident.

SUBTITLE 5. FALSE STATEMENTS

Md. CRIMINAL LAW Code Ann. § 9-501 (2016)

§ 9-501. False statement -- To law enforcement officer

(a) Prohibited. -- A person may not make, or cause to be made, a statement, report, or complaint that the person knows to be false as a whole or in material part, to a law enforcement officer of the State, of a county, municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of the State, or of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Police with intent to deceive and to cause an investigation or other action to be taken as a result of the statement, report, or complaint.

(b) Penalty. -- A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months or a fine not exceeding \$ 500 or both.
