### GENERAL BUSINESS LICENSING APPLICATION FEE

**FOR** the purpose of eliminating a fee for a Town of Riverdale Park general business license application; and generally relating to amendments to the Town's general business licensing ordinance.

Chapter 42 – LICENSES  
Sections 42-4  
Code of the Town of Riverdale Park  
(January 2008 Revision, as supplemented)

**SECTION 1: BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF RIVERDALE PARK,** That Section 42-4 of the Code of the Town of Riverdale Park (January 2008 Revision, as amended), Chapter 42 –LICENSES, is hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

### Chapter 42 – LICENSES

§ 42-4. Application.


26 Any person seeking a license, or the renewal of a license, under this chapter shall  
 27 file with the Town Administrator a written application, under penalty of perjury, in a form  
 28 prescribed by the Town Administrator. An application for the renewal of an existing license  
 29 shall be filed not later than the May 1 before the license is scheduled to expire, unless  
 30 otherwise authorized by the Town Administrator. An application that is filed later than the  
 31 May 15 before the license is scheduled to expire, or such later date as authorized by the  
 32 Town Administrator, shall be treated as a new application. The application for an initial  
 33 license or the renewal of a license shall include or be accompanied by the following to the  
 34 extent reasonably available, and such other information and documentation as the Town  
 35 Administrator reasonably may require:
