- **TV's include CRT TV's 32" & below, flat screens, up to 50"**  
(LCD, LED, Plasma)
- **No computer monitors, CRT TVs over 32", Flat Screen TVs over 50" and any other items not listed here**
- **Limit 2 TV's per household**
