Temple Police Department arrests Bank Jugging suspect

TEMPLE, TX (March 10, 2023) – The Temple Police Department has arrested a bank jugging suspect.

On Thursday, March 9, 2023, 39-year-old Stoney B. Oliver Jr. was arrested during an operation targeting bank jugging suspects in Temple.

Oliver was arrested and taken to the Bell County Jail without incident.

The term bank jugging refers to a type of crime that usually involves a pair of criminals observing customers making large withdrawals at either an ATM or inside a bank. Once a target is selected, the criminals will follow the customer as they leave in their vehicle. They follow until the right opportunity presents itself to steal the customer's withdrawn cash.
