During the November 8 General Election, City of Tucker residents will have an opportunity to vote on a public works referendum that will transition current public works services from DeKalb County and allow the City to assume the day-to-day management responsibilities of its Roads & Maintenance and Stormwater services.

WHAT SERVICES ARE INCLUDED IN PUBLIC WORKS? From pothole repairs and asphalt repairs to catch basin repairs to ongoing right-of-way maintenance, public works services are comprised of two distinct functions: Roads & Maintenance and Stormwater services.

HOW WILL THIS IMPACT ME? An average homeowner with a property valued at \$328,000 would see an increase of \$94 annually for roads and maintenance services and stormwater services combined. Businesses located within the City of Tucker would see proportionate increases as well.

Roads & Maintenance Service Increase: \$70 a year for a home valued at \$328,000
Stormwater Service Increase: \$24 a year
