

DUI VICTIM MEMORIAL WALKWAY

The DUI Victim Memorial Walkway was established in 2005 by the Walla Walla County Traffic Safety and DUI Task Force. Dedicated to those who were taken too soon as a result of a collision caused by someone driving under the influence of alcohol or other drugs, the Walkway is located at the Millcreek Sports Complex on Tausick Way in Walla Walla.

A tree and plaque will be dedicated in honor of those who meet the following criteria:

- The victim must have been a past or present resident of Walla Walla County;
- The victim must have been killed as a result of a vehicle crash, anywhere in the world;
- The crash must have been determined not to be the fault of the victim;
- The driver of the causing vehicle must have been determined to have alcohol or other drugs in his or her blood.

PROGRAM CONTRIBUTIONS

CRITERIA QUALIFICATIONS

Criteria for having a tree and plaque placed at the DUI VICTIM MEMORIAL WALKWAY:

- An immediate family member must contact the Walla Walla County Traffic Safety Task Force requesting that the victims' name be placed at the Memorial Walkway. If there is no immediate family member, a friend may apply.
- The Memorial Walkway Review Committee shall meet to consider the specifics of the crash and determine whether or not the victim qualifies to have a tree and plaque placed at the site. This will allow for a legal opinion, if needed. The Review Committee will forward their decision to the Traffic Safety Task Force Coordinator.
- The Traffic Safety Task Force Coordinator shall present the request to members of the Traffic Safety Task Force at a regularly scheduled meeting for consideration and approval. The Traffic Safety Task Force Coordinator shall notify the applicant of the determination.

COST

The cost per tree and plaque will be based on current rates. The fee will include the tree, plaque and all set up costs. (Some funding assistance may be available through the Traffic Safety Task Force. If assistance is required, please contact the Traffic Safety Task force.) The fee may be paid by the family or through donations given to the Traffic Safety Task Force in the victim's name. Billing will be prepared by the City of Walla Walla. The fees must be paid in advance.
